Christian discipleship invites followers of Christ to seek deeper devotion to God on a continuing basis. Every season of the year is an occasion for doing this. We may engage in personal readings which we refer to as "spiritual devotions." There are endless resources for this type of personal devotion. For instance, you and I may read short daily pieces (such as The Upper Room, Forward Day By Day, Alive Now, These Days, or UCC Still speaking Daily Devotional https://www.ucc.org/ daily devotional). Countless other methods (guided meditation, yoga, silence, etc.) of deepening our spiritual devotion are also possible. Our Savior's invitation to all for the impending Lenten Season is, "Try one."

One simple discipline could be to pray the same prayer every day of Lent. For example, a short prayer like this:

"My God, I am yours for time and eternity. Teach me to cast myself entirely into the arms of your loving Providence. Amen." (excerpt from Suscipe by Catherine McAuley)

Ash Wednesday begins a 40-day season of devotion

to God which extends all the way to Easter Sunday. Each Lenten Season is a grand opportunity; an occasion loaded with potential for new beginnings. One faithful way of regarding this season is as a pilgrimage. Walk in faith from day one to Resurrection Day... and beyond! So much of living as a disciple is about accepting God's offer of re-birth. 





LEARNING ABOUT COUNCIL/BOARDS AND COMMITTEES

ARTICLE XI - BOARD OF CHRISTIAN ACTION

Section 2 - Responsibilities

Glides on preschool chair legs are being replaced.
