

New Arrival

Go to an airport and, even before parking your vehicle, you are greeted by signs with arrows pointing you in the direction of either 'Departures' or 'Arrivals.' Once inside the airport terminal, you cannot elude clusters of electronic monitors displaying flight numbers, up-to-the-minute points of origin and departure times, destinations and arrival times. All of this is helpful information.

In first century Palestine, Mary and Joseph did not enjoy such luxuries. True, God's Archangel Gabriel did inform Mary that - *lo and behold!* - soon she would be expecting an arrival. However, Gabriel provided no details, no specifics. It may be that God's messenger realized it was already overwhelming enough blowing Mary away with the preposterous revelation of her approaching pregnancy! Gabriel did not supply Mary with a time or a location when this Messiah would be coming in for an earthly landing.

After the Annunciation, Mary was aware that she was going to give birth to a child. Yet she was unaware of the birthplace; unaware that she would be bearing her baby all the way to the City of David before he was born! This makes it all the more remarkable that Mary responded to Gabriel, agreeing, "Behold, your handmaid, the servant of the Lord. Let it be with me according to your word." (Luke 1:38)






