Getting to Know You

Music speaks to me. One of the things you will learn about me is how much musical lyrics remain in my memory. If you asked my chaplain colleagues at St. Louis University Hospital, they would tell you an off-hand phrase has frequently led to me singing (somewhat off-key), the lyrics to a song which contain that phrase.

The lyrics which reflect my most important task at Ivy Chapel at this moment is from Rodgers and Hammerstein's *The King and I*: "Getting to know you. Getting to know all about you."

Currently, I am studying the history of Ivy Chapel. I have on my desk the Purpose Statement, Vision Statement, and Mission Statement of the United Church of Christ, the Mission Statement of Ivy Chapel, and your Open and Affirming Covenant. All these historical documents and statements give me an image of who you have been as a faith community. They speak of what is important to you.

These documents are a foundation upon which we can build during this interim process. We will reflect upon them, pray over them, and listen to what the Spirit is speaking to us today. For what has been in the past has led us to this moment. It is our foundation, but it is not our walls. The future of Ivy Chapel is not bound by what has happened in the past because the Spirit of God cannot be limited only to the familiar and the known.

The Spirit will speak to who Ivy Chapel is becoming, the importance of which cannot be overstated. It is vital to have that vision for it will guide the Pastoral Search Committee in selecting a candidate who has the ability and the call to lead and equip the members of Ivy Chapel to fulfill that vision.




"Dreaming God's Dream"
