All: Bless this cup, we pray.

One: Receive our gratitude, O God.

All: Through this simple meal of bread and cup, you offer to bring all people into communion with you, Eternal God. Amen.

One: Let us pray.

we praise you for your gift of new life in Christ.

Loving and Gracious God, we thank you for this holy meal. Thank you for your genuine love for all humanity. Thank you, God, for this sacred table and this special day when the whole world may come together to worship you. Amen.
