Happy New Year! I don't know about you, but I gave up making new year's resolutions many years ago. They just didn't work for me. Instead I have adopted a spiritual approach to enter the new year with an open heart. I surrender my will and seek to hear what God is calling me to let go of or to take up.

This mirrors the process we are in during the interim transition. We as a church are called to let go of the past. We seek to resolve any issues still present, even if not on the surface. We release all the good and all the not-so-good to God and start afresh. And, yes, I know it's not easy. However, we can start the process of releasing these things which hold us back from all God has for us.

One of the things that needs to be released to God: the isolation and fear of the COVID years. I have heard so many times, "well, before COVID, we did..." Now is the time to reflect upon what we gave up that needs to be resurrected in a new way. Worship elements such as passing of the peace have returned. Bringing forward our offerings & pledges for a prayer of dedication will be returning in the Epiphany season. As warmer temperatures return, the deacons and I will discuss how we distribute communion in a manner that is safe, but more appropriate to today.

The Interim Transition Team will be conducting surveys about the ministries of Ivy: what do we need to release; what do we need to take up; what do we need to modify. They will also be leading surveys about the qualities, skills, experience, and spiritual gifts we will seek in a settled pastor. Those surveys will be turned over to the Pastoral Search Committee when formed.

We as a congregation will spend time envisioning the future – dreaming God’s dream for Ivy. We will discuss “who are we?”, “who are we becoming?”, “what are our values?” The answers to those questions will come from the Spirit moving among us all. These are also vital information for the Pastoral Search Committee. We need the person whom God is calling to lead, guide, and empower us to fulfill God’s dream.

There are many things we will discern together about our future. The most important element now is to walk through this time in step with the Spirit. My prayer for Ivy Chapel in the year to come is found in Philippians 3:12-14. The church in Philippi was beloved to the Apostle Paul as you are to me.

“Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal,
but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.
Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it.
But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead,
I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which
God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.”

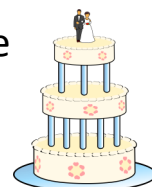
