We hope to post the Settled Pastor position around Easter time.

We will talk about the ministries and programs where we see the Spirit of God moving. We will dream about what we envision for Ivy Chapel in the future. The answers to those questions and the feedback from the surveys will assist the Pastoral Search Team in reviewing applicants.

Ivy Chapel is so very blessed with faithful leadership and with our generous community members. We have so much to offer to the person God will lead to accept the call to be


