# Justice and Peace

With everything going on in the United States and world today it is easy to feel overwhelmed and not know how to help. The United Church of Christ has several different ways you can be a part of helping others in an area you are passionate about.

The Justice and Peace Action Network (JPANet) creates a monthly news letter with information on actions you can take as well as support that is needed in all areas. This month they invite us to join them in being witnesses to what is happening in our communities especially during Black History Month, by sending messages to Congress regarding our concern for future ICE funding and aid to Palestinians in Gaza and Beyond, as well offering as a variety of online seminars on topics from 'Climate Hope' to 'Dismantling White Christian Supremacy' to learning about the ties between 'Venezuela, Oil & U. S. Imperialism'. They also invite UCC youth to participate in the '2026 Climate Hope Art Contest' and a week-long immersion in faith-based advocacy, justice, and community this summer in D.C.
