You may recall last month's congregational letter from our Moderator, John Weiland, explaining Ivy's plan to move forward with upgrading and replacing our front doors. We are pleased to provide this status update on the funding so far. We are replacing our old doors with an ADA compliant automatic door with multiple push buttons for access and a new coded entry system for the safety of everyone using our facilities. As you know, this was an unexpected and very large expense.

Fortunately, due to the generosity of the Ivy community, we have been able to complete the electric work needed already and put down payments for the doors and security system down using our 'Fund the Facility' money and contributions already given. Unfortunately, that will not cover the total expenses.

Expenses:

Electric work: \$885.00 – **Completed and PAID**

ADA & Security Installation work: \$2391.29 –
Deposit paid \$1195.65

Door work: \$10255.00 –
Deposit paid \$ 4563.00

TOTAL: \$13531.29

So far, we have received \$1800 in donations and used \$6644 of our Fund the Facility reserves.
